PART OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE PLAN OF THE 16<sup>TH</sup> JUDICIAL DISTRICT

The Administrative Plan for the 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial District covers all district court proceedings within Fulton County. Fulton County District Court is a local District court having jurisdiction within the physical boundaries of Fulton County. The Court has one elected Judge, Larry Kisse, whose term is from January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2024. The current District Court Clerk is Brandon Holder. Judge Kisse's office is located with the District Clerk's office in Salem Arkansas. Correspondence for both offices should be sent to P.O. Box 928, Salem, Arkansas 72576. Judge Kisse maintains a private practice with an office in Ash Flat, Arkansas. He can be reached at (870) 994-2456 and (870) 994-2345 fax.

The Fulton County District court consists of three (3) departments: Fulton County, City of Salem, and City of Mammoth Spring.

The Court presides over misdemeanors, bond hearings, Rule 8.1 hearings, and extradition hearings as required. All Court sessions for the City of Salem and Fulton County are currently scheduled to be held at the Fulton County Court Annex located at 455 N. Hwy. No. 9, Salem, AR 72576 123 S. Main Street, Salem, Arkansas. All court sessions for the City of Mammoth Spring are scheduled to be held at the Mammoth Spring Police Station, 160 N. Main Street, Mammoth Spring, AR 72554, Mammoth Spring, Arkansas, utilizing the following schedule:

The Court uses the following schedule:


For the City of Salem and Fulton County the Court hears Civil and Small Claims on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the Month at 10:00 A.M.; Criminal and Traffic Plea hearings on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each Month at 10:00 A.M.; and Criminal and traffic trials are held on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of each Month at 1 P.M.

For the City of Mammoth Spring, the Court hears Civil and Small Claims on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of every other month at 10:00 A.M. and Criminal and Traffic Plea hearings and arraignments on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of the month at 10:00 A.M.; and Criminal and traffic trials are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of every other month at 10:00 A.M. This schedule is subject to change depending on the availability of courtrooms.

Part of the city of Cherokee Village, Arkansas, lies within Fulton County. The city has its own police force which also provides services to that part of the city that lies within Fulton County. Therefore, because of geographical considerations and to conserve resources and expenses, Fulton County District Judge Larry Kisse has entered in an agreement with State District Court Judge Mark Johnson of the 11<sup>th</sup> District State Court that provides that those criminal and traffic offenses occurring in Cherokee Village, Fulton County, are to be heard in the 11<sup>th</sup> District State

Court in Cherokee Village. The exchange agreement provides that Judge Johnson will preside over criminal and traffic cases that occur in the Fulton County part of the city of Cherokee Village. The exchange agreement was entered pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 16-17-102.

**AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE FOR ARREST**

In The Matter of: DAVE CAMPBELL

W/M AGE: 68

Re: Request for Magistrates Determination for Probable Cause for Warrant of Arrest for the Defendant on the following charges:

**5-13-203. Battery in the third degree x3**

(a) A person commits battery in the third degree if:

(1) With the purpose of causing physical injury to another person, the person causes physical injury to any person;

**5-71-207. Disorderly conduct**

(a) A person commits the offense of disorderly conduct if, with the purpose to cause public inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm or recklessly creating a risk of public inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm, he or she:

(1) Engages in fighting or in violent, threatening, or tumultuous behavior

THE UNDERSIGNED, BEING DULY SWORN, FOR HIS AFFIDAVIT FOR PROBABLE CAUSE FOR ARREST, DEPOSES AND SAYS:

On 7/19/2024 at approximately 1:00 PM, I Assistant Chief John Barnett conducted an interview with Gary Dunn, Randy Dunn, and Brenda Dunn. During this interview Mr. Gary stated that on 7/16/2024 at approximately 9:26 AM, he along with his wife Mrs. Brenda and brother Mr. Randy came into City Hall to show a warranty deed of the house that their mother Ms. Betty Dunn currently resides in at 435 Bethel Ave in Mammoth Spring, AR. After showing the deed they informed City Hall that they were going to put up no trespassing signs on their property as soon as they left. They also told City Hall to inform the Police Department that they might be needed because of some neighbors to the property a Mr. Dave and Dawn Campbell being in a property dispute over the house at 435 Bethel Ave in Mammoth Spring AR. At approximately 9:46 AM as Mr. Gary was heading into his mother's "Ms. Betty's" home he noticed Mrs. Campbell was walking toward Ms. Betty's home, she quickly turned around and ran to her residence. Mr. Gary said that he seen Mr. Campbell become visibly irate

practically running up to their property with Mrs. Campbell right behind him. As the Campbell's made it onto their property Mr. Gary asked if Mr. Campbell had a weapon, they both stated they did while placing their hands on their waste line indicating they were carrying firearms. Mr. Gary then told them that they needed to leave the property they both refused, instead Mr. Campbell started calling Mr. Gary and Mr. Rany idiots, constantly insulting them and their intelligence. During this time Mr. Gary noticed his mother being visibly upset, as he tried to make his way to Ms. Betty to check on her, Mr. Campbell stepped in front of him to block his path. Mr. Gary then tried to step around Mr. Campbell, Mr. Campbell chest bumped Mr. Gary and stated loudly "You pushed me"! Then Mr. Campbell hit Mr. Gary with his left closed fist in Mr. Gary's stomach, Mr. Campbell then vigorously pushed Mr. Gary to the ground with both hands. Mrs. Campbell then screamed at Mr. Campbell stop and calm down. Mr. Campbell immediately turned his aggression toward Mr. Randy, Mr. Gary's brother, Mr. Campbell pushed Mr. Randy then yelled you pushed me, then pushed Mr. Randy even harder causing him to stumble and he would've fell if he didn't hit his back on the pole that holds the carport up. Then Mr. Campbell turned back towards Mr. Gary and Mrs. Brenda, Mr. Gary's wife, got out of their vehicle, went to Mr. Campbell and while shaking her finger in his face said stop pushing my husband around. Mr. Campbell then said nobody shakes their finger in my face, so Mrs. Brenda shook it again in his face, Mr. Campbell then kneed Mrs. Brenda in the middle of her lower stomach, Mrs. Benda then immediately after being kneed said may God bless you. Mr. Campbell replied God is with me! After being kneed in the stomach Mrs. Brenda got back in her vehicle, went to City Hall, and asked for help. By the time she arrived back at the scene Officer Hunter Crawford was on scene. Due to the above stated facts, I Assistant Chief John Barnett of the Mammoth Spring Police Department am charging Mr. Dave Campbell with 3 counts of Battery in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and 1 count of Disorderly Conduct. 



The Arkansas Secretary of State has received a complaint concerning your actions as a commissioned Notary Public. The complaint alleges that you improperly notarized a document(s) on or about July 22, 2024. A copy of the notarized document in question is enclosed for your convenience.


According to the complaint, The document contains your notarization of signature(s) that were allegedly administered incorrectly. Allegedly the signature of Assistant Chief John Barnett was signed by Officer Hunter Crawford and was not done in person and/or forged. Notarized documents should be done on the same day while witnessing the signer sign.

Before a notary begins the process of notarizing the document, the notary needs to be conscious of the situation. In addition to verifying the identity of the signer(s), the notary needs to check that the signer(s): 1. Understand the nature of the document they are about to sign 2. Appear to be acting of their own free will 3. Use letter or characters that are understood by both the signer(s) and notary 4. Communicate directly with the notary in a language understood by both the client(s) and notary.

Your duties as a notary public are limited to the power and duties set forth in A.C.A. §21-14-104 "...(1)The purpose of swearing witnesses; (2) Taking affidavits and depositions; and (3) Taking acknowledgements of deeds and other instruments in writing and authorized by law to be acknowledged." As a Notary Public, you may not offer legal advice, services or assistance with documents you will notarize. You may not attest to the validity or legality of a document. You should verify they are not signing under duress, and/or are of sound mind.

It is very important to take care in notarizing documents. If you are "found by a court to have improperly notarized documents according to the law" (Ark. Code Ann. § 21-14-112) the Secretary of State would have grounds to revoke your commission. Whether the complainant decides to pursue this action with a law enforcement agency, or a court, and the ultimate disposition of the matter will determine the possibility of this happening.

Generally, this Office does not have authority to revoke a Notary Commission, or take any other disciplinary action, absent a court order. If you wish to bring formal action against the notary public and/or declare the documents void, please contact a private attorney and pursue this matter in the judicial system. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide any legal assistance.

If and when the notary public is found by a court to have improperly notarized documents according to the law - either criminally or civilly - then this office would have grounds to revoke a commission or take other applicable action in accordance with a court order. A copy of the Arkansas Notary Handbook and Arkansas Notary Law may be found on our website ([www.sos.arkansas.gov](http://www.sos.arkansas.gov)) for your review.

If you believe criminal conduct occurred, such a forgery or fraud, we encourage you to contact your local prosecuting attorney. If you cannot afford representation, you may reach out to Arkansas Center for Legal Services.

Hello Melissa,

Thank you for speaking with me today. You may know the 14th State District Court (Ind, IZARD & FULTON COUNTIES) Administrative Plan for 2026-2027 is due July 1, 2025 and I am in the process of getting it finalized & then submitted to the Administrative Office of the Courts. However, per A.C.A. §16-17-1116, Mammoth Spring is a designated department of Fulton County Dist Court, so I need an ordinance from the Mammoth City Council waiving the holding of court there once per month. The requirement comes from the following statute:

Pursuant to A.C.A. §16-17-138, sessions of court must be held at least one (1) time per month in each department unless mutually waived by the district court judge and the governing body of the city or town where the department is located.

Chief Tumbough informed me earlier that hearing Mammoth cases in Salem would be fine, but apparently a written agreement/ordinance to that effect is needed for the Administrative Plan. So, if you or the Mammoth City Attorney could get that to me asap, I would appreciate it. In the interim, I will go ahead & submit the Plan stating that such an agreement/ordinance is in the works, and amend it later to include the ordinance.

If you or the Mammoth City Attorney wish to discuss this further or need help with the wording of the ordinance, please contact me and I'm certainly happy to do so.

**July 07, 2025 Mammoth Spring City Council Regular Meeting**

MAYOR BUSCH: Okay. Now we go to the ordinance regarding the court.

ATTORNEY HASS: And on that we had just received -- Actually, Melissa had

received from Judge Taylor -- Judge Taylor who's the 14<sup>th</sup> Arkansas 14th Circuit (sic)

District Court Judge which uh -- anyhow the -- Under the Court Admin Office of State

Court Administrators is what I'm used to calling but that's really a term in Missouri. I

think in Arkansas they just call it Arkansas Office of Court Administration or something

like that. But in any event, they want these district courts -- These district circuits,

because it's not the circuit court. They have the district courts, which have a circuit like

the circuit court does, to have an agreement with any municipality that's considered its

own division or its own department, which the City of Mammoth Spring does. And of

course, historically had its own municipal court and, uh, then transferred the court -- the

municipal court to the circuit court -- or excuse me to the district court '10 or '15. I'm

### **LETTER OF ADMONISHMENT**

Dear Judge Taylor:

You were alleged to have committed violations of the Arkansas Code of Judicial Conduct in Case No. 22-131. The following facts comprise the violations which you agree are no longer alleged but proven:

#### **UNDISPUTED FACTS:**

1. Judge Chaney Taylor (hereinafter referred to as "*Taylor*") has served as a district court judge in Independence County, Arkansas, for almost 19 years.
2. JDDC Investigation Panel 3 authorized a full investigation of the allegations against Taylor. The staff of the JDDC obtained, analyzed, and presented to the Panel: court records and dockets, witness statements and letters, information pertaining to Quorum Court matters, investigation information from law enforcement agencies, an audio recording (dash camera footage), and Taylor's responses to the allegations.
3. During the course of the investigation of JDDC Case No. 22-131, the Judicial Discipline & Disability Commission ("JDDC") confirmed that, following a phone call from a third party informing of him of the situation and a request for assistance, Taylor contacted an Arkansas State

Trooper while the Trooper was transporting an individual charged with speeding and reckless driving.

4. Taylor asked that the Trooper give the suspect a citation instead of transporting the suspect to jail. When the Trooper told Taylor that Arkansas State Police protocol for transporting the suspect to jail had been initiated, Taylor asked that the suspect be released on his own recognizance and given a court date. The suspect did not have a previous criminal history and later entered a negotiated plea to the speeding charge. Pursuant to the negotiation, the prosecution nolle prossed the reckless driving charge.
5. Taylor accepts full responsibility for his conduct and has indicated that he will not initiate similar communications with law enforcement in the future.
6. Taylor has been open and candid in communications with the JDDC in compliance with Canon 2, Rule 2.16 and has willingly provided additional information throughout the investigation when requested by JDDC staff or the Investigation Panel.

**RELEVANT AUTHORITY:**

The Judicial Discipline and Disability Commission determined, and you agree, that the above described behavior violated the following sections of the Code of Judicial Conduct (*hereinafter referred to as the "Code"*): Rules 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3.

**CANON 1**

**A JUDGE SHALL UPHOLD AND PROMOTE THE INDEPENDENCE, INTEGRITY, AND IMPARTIALITY OF THE JUDICIARY, AND SHALL AVOID IMPROPRIETY AND THE APPEARANCE OF IMPROPRIETY.**

**RULE 1.1 Compliance with the Law**

A judge shall comply with the law, including the Arkansas Code of Judicial Conduct.

**RULE 1.2 Promoting Confidence in the Judiciary**

A judge shall act at all times in a manner that promotes public confidence in the independence, integrity, and impartiality of the judiciary, and shall avoid impropriety and the appearance of impropriety.

RULE 1.3 Avoiding Abuse of Prestige of Judicial Office

A judge shall not abuse the prestige of judicial office to advance the personal or economic interests of the judge or others, or allow others to do so.

CONCLUSION:

You agree that an admonishment is the appropriate sanction for your actions in JDDC Case #22-131. Your willingness to accept that your actions were in violation of the Code and your commitment to be aware of these issues in the future led the Investigation Panel to refrain from recommending a more serious sanction to the Commission, authorizing public charges, or proceeding to a public disciplinary hearing. An admonishment can be viewed as more of a corrective sanction. It is an expression of disapproval of a judge's conduct and may contain a proscriptive to follow a corrective course of conduct.

Public confidence in the judiciary is eroded by improper conduct committed by a judge. As such, inappropriate interactions with law enforcement, however well-meaning, impugn the integrity of the judiciary. Your promise to avoid such behavior in the future resolved this matter without further proceedings. However, if there are additional complaints filed against you in the future that allege violations of the Code, the JDDC may initiate a new investigation under the Rules of Procedure of the Judicial Discipline & Disability Commission, and this case may be considered.

In view of these circumstances, it is the decision of the Judicial Discipline & Disability Commission that you are hereby admonished for your conduct at issue in #22-131. This Commission action is public information.

2 THE COURT: Now, they might not defend, but  
3 they're -- but those people aren't even sued in this  
4 lawsuit. It's kind of like in this lawsuit, if you  
5 decided that -- to have, you know, the arrest warrant  
6 for -- who's a famous criminal? -- Jesse James set  
7 aside; okay? You've gotta serve the right people.  
8 You've gotta serve the people that issued the arrest  
9 warrant for Jesse James. This man's been, perhaps,  
10 subpoena as a witness, but he's not been sued, and  
11 the Mammoth Police Department hasn't been sued. And,  
12 I mean, it can be done, but you have to sue the right  
13 people to do it. How does this case have -- how in  
14 this case, which is Turnbough versus Campbell, is  
15 there jurisdiction for me to take up the subject  
16 matter? And where are all the necessary parties,  
17 being the City of Mammoth Springs? Assuming it's a  
18 city arrest warrant. I haven't seen this arrest  
19 warrant.

20 MR. CAMPBELL: It is.

21 THE COURT: So that's my question.

22 MR. CAMPBELL: Well, it's all fraudulent, and  
23 James Turnbough is the police chief there over Mr.  
24 Barnett and over Mr. Crawford, and they work directly  
25 for him. Mr. Turnbough stood down and lied to

1 dispatch five times on --

2 THE COURT: But he hasn't been sued -- he's been  
3 sued in his individual capacity and not in his  
4 professional capacity, I take it, from this lawsuit?  
5 Am I wrong about that?

6 MR. CAMPBELL: Well, this is beyond the scope of  
7 their official duty. This is them on their own.

8 THE COURT: Okay.

9 MR. CAMPBELL: They're -- he's just threw  
10 caution to the wind.

11 THE COURT: Did he sign this warrant?

12 MR. CAMPBELL: He had his hatchet men do it,  
13 his --

14 THE COURT: Okay. So deputies did it?

15 MR. CAMPBELL: John Barnett and Crawford. Yes,  
16 ma'am.

17 THE COURT: Okay. So deputies did it.

18 MR. CAMPBELL: Assistant Police Chief, this guy  
19 is.

20 THE COURT: Okay. But this guy hasn't been  
21 sued?

22 MR. CAMPBELL: No, but he's, you know -- the --

23 THE COURT: You have to -- when you're voiding  
24 an arrest warrant, you've got to serve the parties to  
25 the arrest warrant. And the parties to the arrest

1 warrant are either the State of Arkansas versus the  
2 defendant or, in this case, it may be the City of  
3 Mammoth Springs against the defendant. But they're  
4 not parties to this lawsuit. So without proper  
5 service, there's no due process, which is -- you guys  
6 are Constitution people. You'll understand that.  
7 You have to serve the people to do that, so if you  
8 can serve the right people -- if you file a lawsuit  
9 to void this arrest warrant, and you sue the right  
10 people and give them notice -- that's the whole  
11 service thing, the whole Rule 4 thing -- I'll be glad  
12 to hear this case.

13 But on this particular case, I don't think we've  
14 got the right people in front of the Court. We've  
15 got James Turnbough, but that's not the City of  
16 Mammoth. And you're before the Court, but not on  
17 anything to do with this arrest warrant. I mean,  
18 there could be a completely -- you may have been  
19 arrested on a completely fraudulent warrant. Let's  
20 just assume that that's true. Even if I -- if I  
21 assume that that's true. I haven't heard any facts.

22 MR. CAMPBELL: Secretary of State verified that.

23 THE COURT: Well, the Secretary of State  
24 apparently did something regarding the notary, but --

25 MR. CAMPBELL: Yes, which voided the --

1 THE COURT: Which would definitely impact the  
2 credibility of the warrant. I get you. I'm  
3 following you there. But you don't have the City of  
4 Mammoth sued here, or the State of Arkansas. This  
5 was two misdemeanors, and it was in the Circuit Court  
6 of -- let me see which court it was.

7 MR. CAMPBELL: It was three misdemeanors and a  
8 dis -- well, four, actually. It was three batteries  
9 and a disorderly. And --

10 THE COURT: Is this Judge Weaver -- this is in  
11 Judge Weaver's court, so --

12 MR. CAMPBELL: Judge Weaver signed the  
13 fraudulent document as well. As a matter of fact, he  
14 was hoodwinked by Mr. Plumlee.

15 THE COURT: And you can sue Judge Weaver if you  
16 want to, but he's not got -- I mean, in order for me  
17 to do that, you've gotta sue the right people.

18 MR. CAMPBELL: Okay.

19 THE COURT: And Judge Weaver's not a party to  
20 this lawsuit. He hasn't been served any notice. He  
21 doesn't -- you know, you can't set aside -- I can't  
22 just randomly set things aside when the parties  
23 aren't noticed up about it. So there's not  
24 sufficient notice on your due process, so I think his  
25 objection's valid.

1 MR. CAMPRELL: Okay, so you can't void that  
2 anyway, then?

3 **COURT'S RULING AS TO DEFENDANTS' MOTION**  
4 **TO DECLARE 7/22/24 AFFIDAVIT VOID**

5 THE COURT: Okay. So I'm going to -- no, I can  
6 if the right people are sued, and they haven't been  
7 in this case. So the motion to declare the affidavit  
8 void is denied for lack of jurisdiction.

9 **(WHEREUPON, further proceedings were held in the**  
10 **matter which were not requested transcribed.)**

**AFFIDAVIT OUTLINING FACTS SUPPORTING  
DEFENDANT'S CLAIM OF IMPROPER SERVICE**

COMES NOW AFFIANT, Dave Campbell, testifying under oath, as follows:

1. The date of my arrest was August 02, 2024 and the date of the arraignment was January 28, 2025. There is a gap of approximately five months and twenty-six days.
